- Poor coordination between cities and volunteers

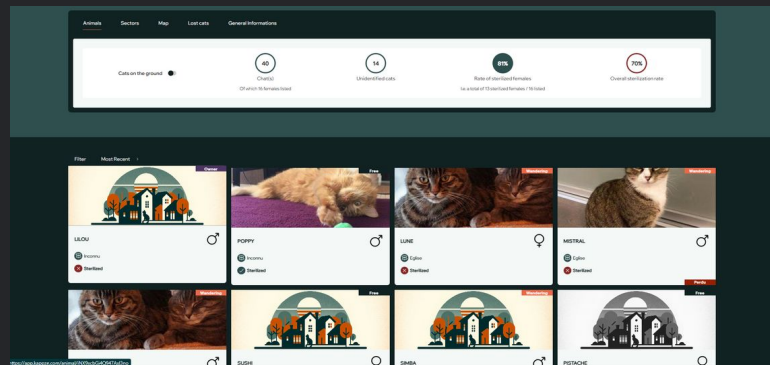
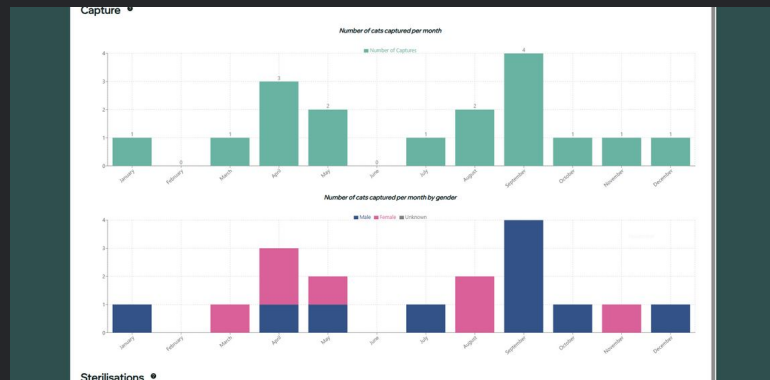
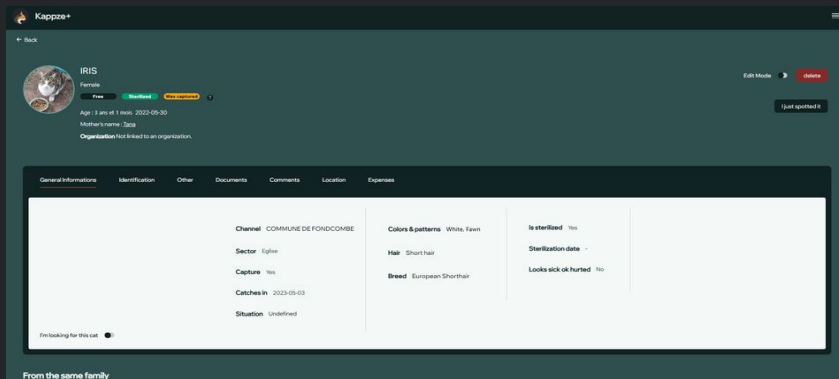


The Kappze Solution

How to start on Kappze



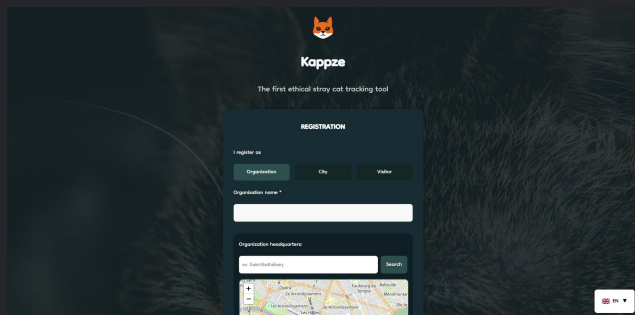
Register yourself

Register your municipality or organization and set your account location. Then create your first Channel.

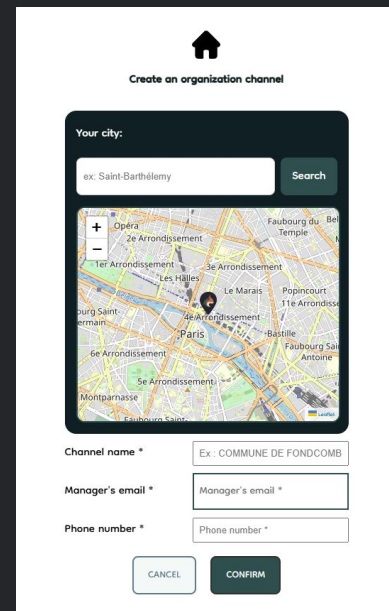
Choose the right account type :

- If you're registering as a City, you become the official maintainer of this city. Recommended if you're a Municipality.
- If you're registering as an Organization, you will not be the official maintainer but you can add this City as a Channel. Recommended if you're an Organization working across multiple cities.
- If you're registering as a Visitor, make sure you're Organization or City has a visible channel.

After joining it, you can add your cat(s) and start signal animals.

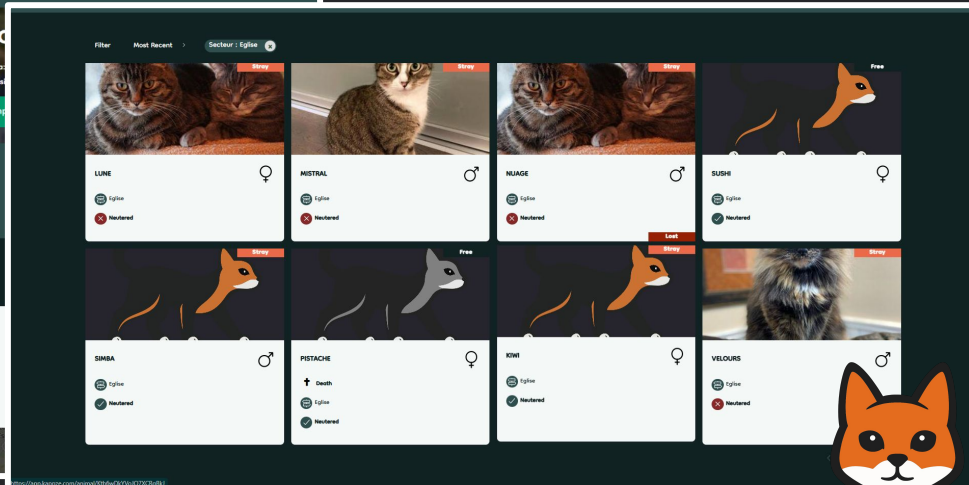
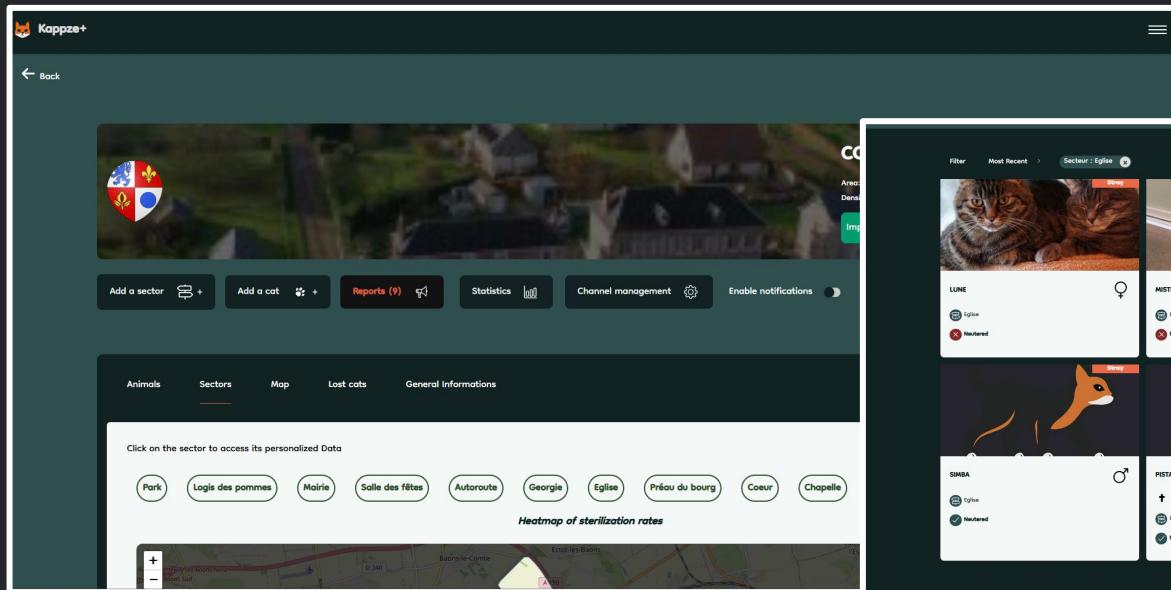
Once your first sectors are set up, access them here or filter your Home list by sector.

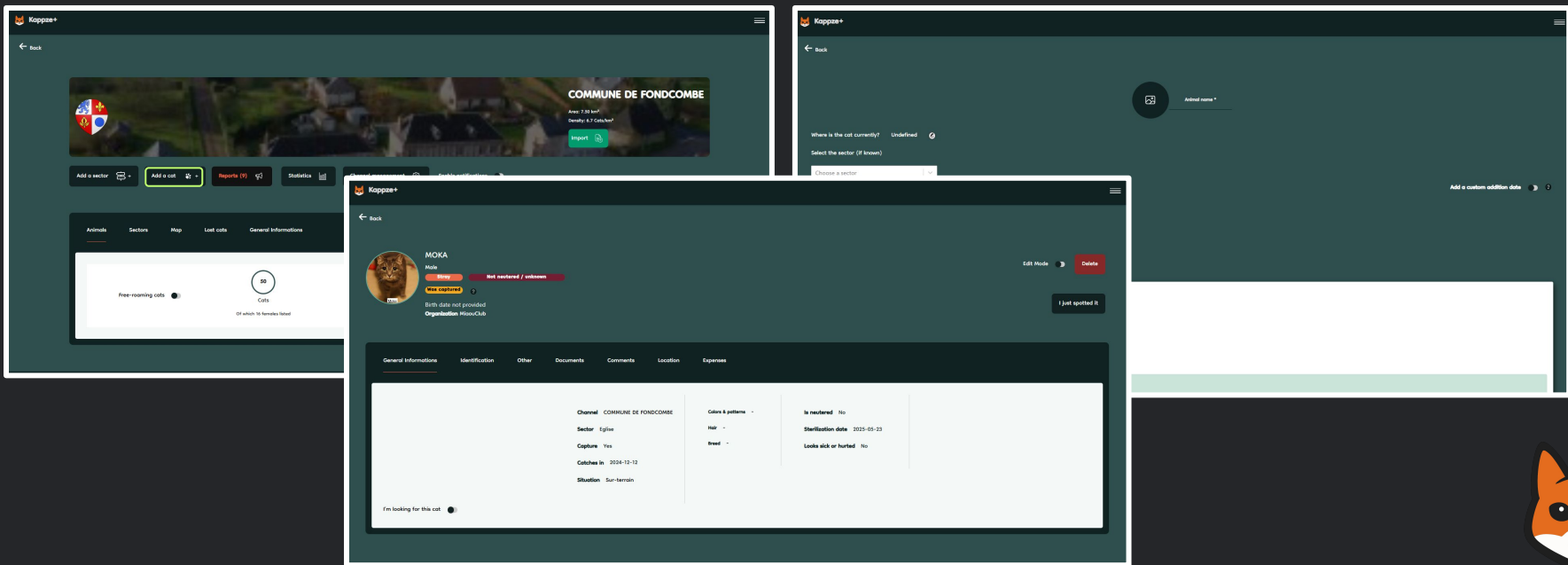
Homepage

The Home-page includes useful shortcuts and key metrics. From here, you can access overall statistics, the full cat list with filters, and the map. It's your main dashboard. For sector-specific statistics or animal lists, click a sector name.



The Cats

Each cat has its own profile, and these profiles power the statistics. As a Channel Administrator, you can add or moderate reports and edit entries quickly. The more precise your entries, the more accurate the automated statistics.

A cat profile can include key information. You can assign it to a sector, pin its location on the map, attach documents, add comments, and record expenses. The more complete the profile, the more accurate your automated statistics become.

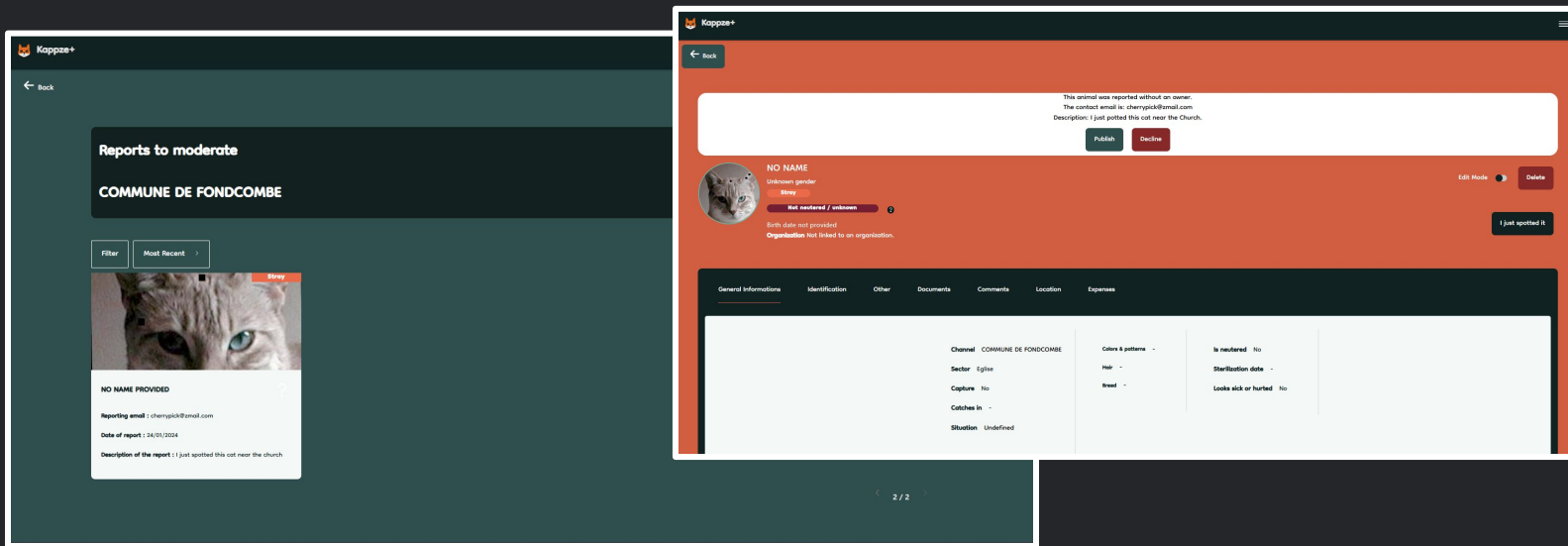

The Reports

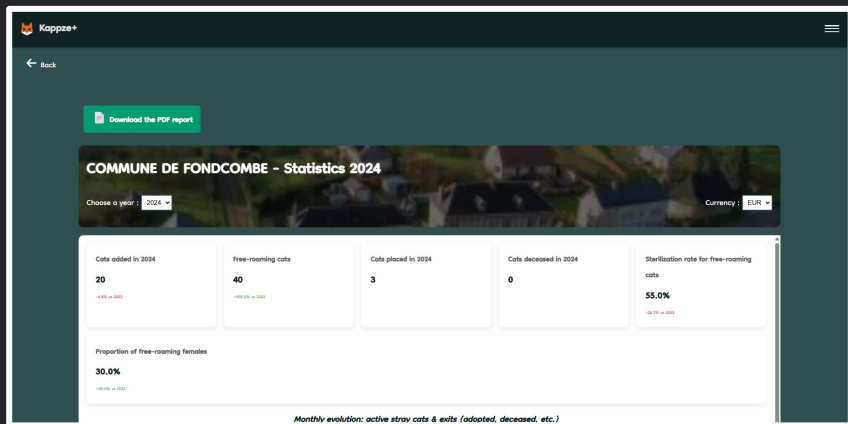
Visitors can report stray cats or add their own pets. As an Administrator, you can review and moderate all submissions. Reports can include photos, locations, and descriptions. A structured, pre-built form standardizes data—no custom setup required. You can edit a report like a normal cat profile and publish it when relevant.

On the Home page, you'll find overall statistics and shortcuts to detailed metrics. These stats are auto-generated and downloadable as PDF.

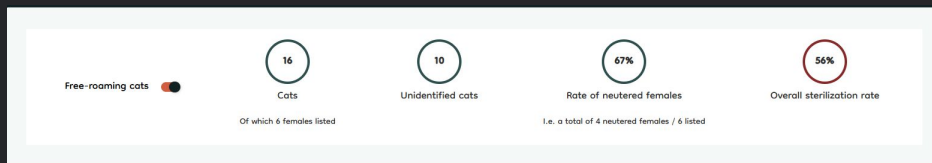
They include: sterilization rates, identification rates, heatmap views, expenses, and year-over-year comparisons—everything you need for a successful TNR strategy.
